## Statement on Baptism and Church Membership

We, the board of overseers, reaffirm the biblical mandate of believers baptism by immersion and that it be a prerequisite for church membership as stated in the BGC Constitution.

We further recommend that, if in the process of reaching people from diverse backgrounds, a local church establishes different levels of association for the purpose of allowing people to identify with a BGC church while they consider church membership:

- 1. The church should affirm in its Constitution, Articles of Incorporation, or By Laws, the biblical practice of believers baptism by immersion.
- 2. A term other than "church member" be used to identify these people.
- 3. Spiritual leadership positions (such as pastor, elder, deacon, governing board), the privilege of voting on constitutional changes, and the calling of a pastor be constitutionally limited to those who are church members, and
- 4. All delegates to district and BGC meetings be church members.
