Qualifications:

- Demonstrate a personal relationship with Jesus and a desire to share that with others.
- Good biblical leadership skills (prayerful, listener, work ethic, humble, loyal, responsible).
- Called by God into this area of ministry.
- Confident musician who expresses the difference between worship and performance.
- Experience leading worship.
- Knowledge of audio technology (sound board, microphones, etc.).
- Knowledge of livestreaming, Proclaim Presentation software, CCLI reporting or willingness to learn.
- Member of Hillside Community Church or willing to become one.

Responsibilities:

- Provide leadership over the Sunday morning service (worship / slides, announcements scheduled).
- Develop and oversee a worship team schedule using a worship planning program (Churchtrac).
- Ensure that the livestream is working each week and train others to facilitate as needed.
- Ensure that the worship team is confidently prepared to lead the church in worship.
- Meet with the Lead Pastor weekly to discuss upcoming services and the leading of the Spirit.
- Be evaluated yearly by the Lead Pastor on the successes and growth points of the ministry.
- Work jointly with the Lead Pastor and other staff to effectively carry out the ministry of Hillside.

Hours and Pay:

Part time: 10 hours a week on average. Salaried position.
