QUALIFICATIONS: Our Worship Pastor should demonstrate Christian character and servant leadership as stated in 1 Timothy 3:1-7, Titus 1:5-9, and 1 Peter 5:1-4. He or she should be committed to personal spiritual growth, creative, teachable, willing to follow, and able to lead.

SOME GENERAL ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Lead worship in our weekend services (10-15 hours per week, for further discussion of what this could look like)
- Have strong musical experience, and proficiency in one or more instruments such as guitar and piano
- Be a leader who is able to raise up other worship leaders, develops our worship team, and recruits musicians
- Coordinate ways to improve our overall worship experience
- Participate in leadership meetings and help the direction of our church
- Work with the senior/teaching pastor to develop series
- Draft worship schedules and worship set lists for services
- Lead worship team practices
- Read and write both chord and score music charts
- Understand basic structures of vocal harmony to perform and teach assigned vocal parts
- Basic technical knowledge of sound system/mixing helpful

WEEKLY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Pastor musicians/vocalists (also just hang out, listen, jam, get to know them)
- Pastor people in the church too, not just musicians (10-15 hours per week, for further discussion of what this could look like)
- Recruit musicians (already can play, and those who don't but have an interest and the right heart and would need lessons, coaching, etc)
- Praying before or after rehearsal
- Teach and explain "worship" during service. The why for singing, clapping, participating from a scriptural perspective
