Coaching Guide #4: Launch Team Development

Definition

Launch Team: The group of people who help you get the church launched. A short term group that meets for a defined purpose and a specific amount of time.

General guidelines:

- The Launch date is important, but think of it as set in wet cement. Better to change the launch than to launch unprepared.
- Your team follows your lead: You are setting the culture of your church. How hard will you work, what pace will you run at, when will you rest, etc.?
- Proceed with caution: your vision is vulnerable right now. People need more than a pulse they need to buy in to YOU and YOUR VISION.
- Don't be quick to hand out titles or to promise positions.

Finding people:

- Friends and family
- Personal evangelism
- Other churches (with permission)
- · Community involvement: clubs, meet up groups, chamber, kids sports and school
- Online (social media, blogs, etc.)

Things to focus on:

- Vision casting (paint a sunset of what your vision looks like and get people to see it)
- · Pastor your team
- Facilitate discussion and catch them getting it right "YES!"
- Give assignments demographics, outreach, read books, etc.
- Work on projects use the time to test people, find leaders, gather more members
- · Develop leaders
- Have fun celebrate, get outside
- Invest in kids they should look forward to your meetings!


